This course will cover a variety of skills that will have overarching themes for your assignment briefs. You will study graphic design, commercial photography, digital illustration, motion graphics and app design. You should show a mood-board of examples of mascots for research and this should be annotated with your thought process. You could work on one design or a series of designs to help you create your mascot. You can use the Internet to gather inspiration and use books if you can access them.
